History of presenting complaint:

S: top of penis
Q: Like a sharp tingling pain
I: 7/10
T: started with soe discomfort and itching then became painful and now have bumps.
A: Not really
R: tried some lotion but didn't help
S: The don't bleed or ooze but have noticed pain when peeing

Other relevant symptoms: none

Sexual history: Never had any STI or anything like this before. Well I have had two or three male partners in last 2/3weeks. We didn't use protection and had anal and oral sex.

ICE: Have I got an STI? Just want something to help? Maybe some cream or medication

PMH: None

DHx: No drugs taken and no allergies

FHx: None

SHx: Smokes 5 cigarettes a day for last 2 years

Systems review: No other relevant history
