

## OSCE Examination Examiners Marksheet

### **Opening and Patient care**

- Introduces themselves, gains consent and washes hands
- Correct positioning of patient
- Appropriate interaction during examination
- Ensures patient comfort during examination
- General inspection
- Appropriate examination of patient's surroundings
- General inspection of patient in relation to system being examined

### **Physical examination**

- Checks hands including nails
- Checks CO2 flap
- Inspects eyes and mouth
- Palpate lymph nodes
- Confirms position of trachea
- Checks lung expansion
- Auscultation, percussion and vocal resonance both anteriorly and posteriorly
- Checks legs
- Good examination technique
- States appropriate additional information to complete examination

### **Completing the examination**

- Thank patient, allow them to re-dress
- States appropriate additional relevant investigations/ test
- Appropriate communication of clinical findings
- Confident, accurate and clear

- FBC, U+Es, CRP
